Each Newsletter we will remind you of Two of our Rules

Remember on the Non-Public or Member days each of you are Range Safety Officers (RSO's).

Targets: NEVER SHOOT AT ANYTHING OTHER THAN YOUR TARGET, including someone else's target. (Shooting station and target frames are numbered for your convenience.) Paper targets may be stapled (recommended), tacked, or taped to the target frames below the white line and centered horizontally, away from the frame's side supports.

Photography: Never take pictures or record video of other people or their property without their prior permission.
